

Agnes Adam

12 September 1860 - 5 October 1947

Agnes was born in Glasgow on 12th September 1860. Her parents were John Lindsay Adam and Maria Dennison. Maria had been born in Java, Indonesia, her mother Anthonia Theodora Cornelia Hillegonda Mooyaert was Dutch.

Agnes never married and lived most of her life with her parents. In 1881 they were living in Southsea, Portsmouth, but by 1891 the census records the family in Clifton Road, Hornsey, Middlesex. Her father's occupation was listed as "living on own means" which indicates a private income.

Agnes was the cousin of Cornelia Van Ufford. Maria Dennison's sister was Anna Dennison. (see Van Ufford family)

Agnes died on 5th October 1947, aged 87, and was buried in the same plot as her cousin, Cornelia Hillegonda Quarles Van Ufford, who had died in 1940. She was buried in Danehill cemetery on 9th October 1947
