

# Grace Susie Bellerby

## 1896 - 10th August 1900

Grace Susie Bellerby was born in 1896 in Greater London

She died on 10 August 1900 at the age of 4 and is buried in the Danehill Cemetery. Her death certificate states the cause of death as diphtheria, a common disease in children in the 19th century. It was not until 1940 that a vaccine was offered free to all British children. It is unclear why Grace was buried in Danehill, as no connection with the Bellerby family.

Her father William Albert Bellerby came from London and was born in Marylebone, in April 1859. He was a Tailor by trade employing other workers, and in 1891 lived at 82, Clifton Hill Marylebone, they were employing a general servant, Annie Sweet. Later they moved to 91, Belsize Road, Hampstead. William died 24th August 1938 in Worthing, Sussex. His address at that time was 37, Gaisford Road, Worthing. He left £6,499 10s in his Will.

Grace's mother Minnie Preston was also born in Marylebone in 1873. Minnie also died in Worthing in 1954.

William and Minnie had two other children after Grace died, who both went on to have successful careers.

Charles William Bellerby born 1901 married Elsie May Mullins and his profession was a Research Physiologist. At the time of his death on 27th October 1954 he and Elsie were living at 161a, Finchley Road, Hampstead. In his Will he left £6,630. 11s. to his widow Elsie.

Owen Henry Bellerby, Grace's other brother, married Phyllis Windebank and they lived in Folkestone, Kent. Owen was a Medical Practitioner. He died at The Royal Victoria Hospital, Folkestone on 21st March 1950. At the time of his death was living at 35, Wear Bay Road, Folkestone. He left £15,244. 7s. 2d. in his Will. Phyllis died in 2000 aged 90 years.

Going further back in the family, Grace's grandfather was Charles Bellerby (1826-1915). A tailor by trade.

He married Margaret Law and in 1861 they were living in High Road, Hanwell, Middlesex. The 1871 census records the family living at Woodland Cottage, Ealing, by this time William and Margaret had 10 children. When Charles died they were living at 32, St. Aubyns Road, Brighton. He left £6,029. 8s. 6d in his Will.

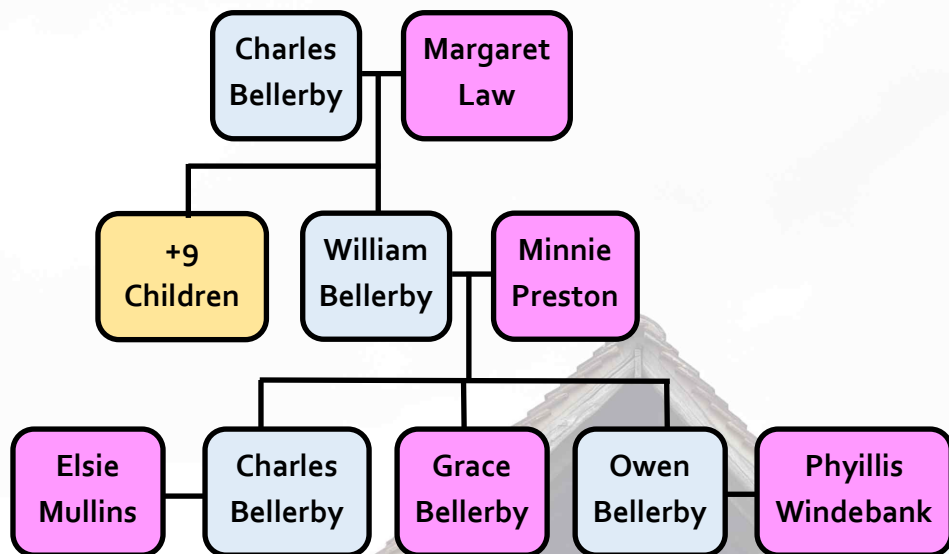
