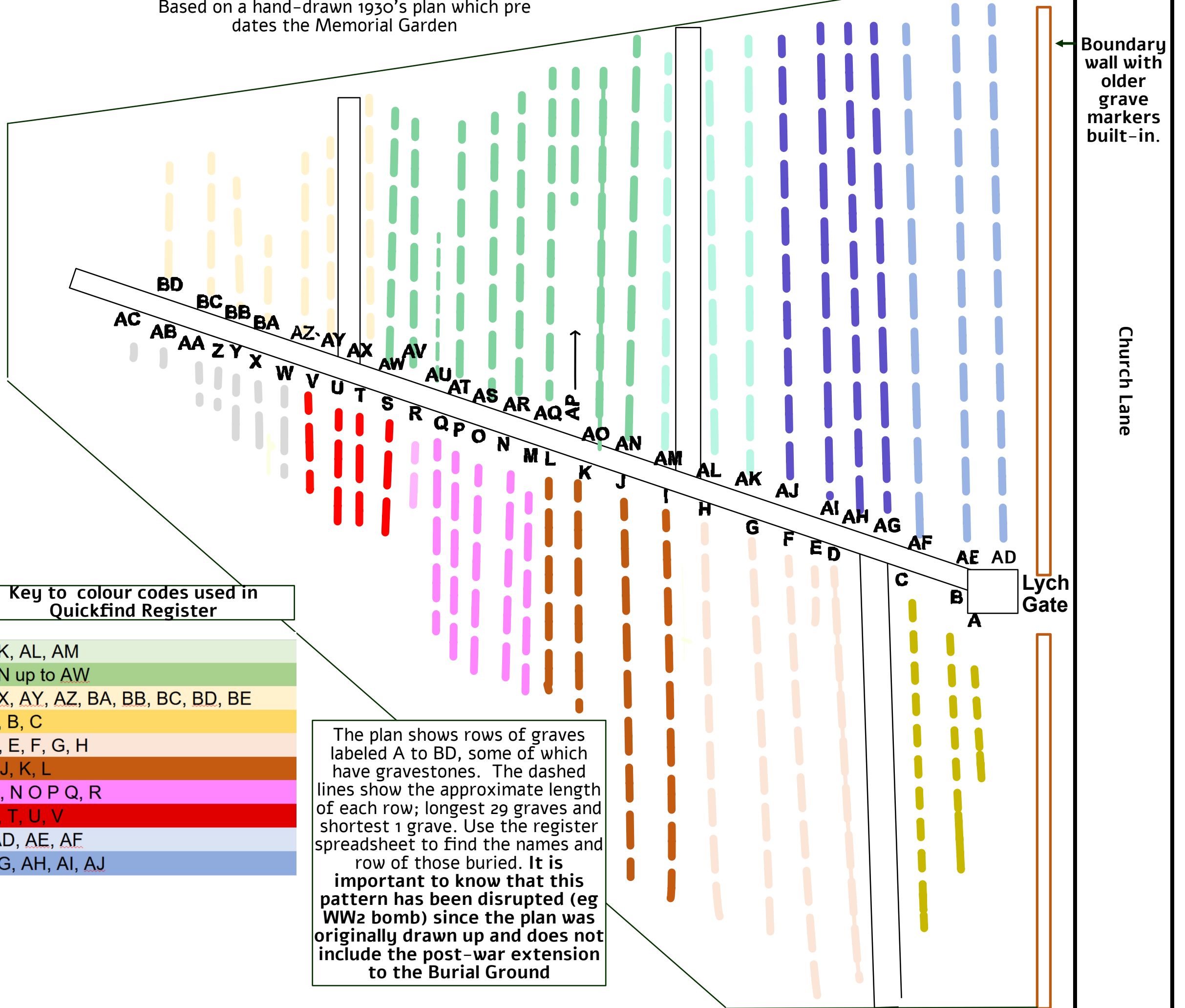


Danehill Parish Burial Ground Plan.

Based on a hand-drawn 1930's plan which pre-dates the Memorial Garden

The plan shows rows of graves labeled A to BD, some of which have gravestones. The dashed lines show the approximate length of each row; longest 29 graves and shortest 1 grave. Use the register spreadsheet to find the names and row of those buried. **It is important to know that this pattern has been disrupted (eg WW2 bomb) since the plan was originally drawn up and does not include the post-war extension to the Burial Ground**
