

Elizabeth Kate Evered (nee Hastings)

21 March 1867 - 29 September 1952

Elizabeth Kate Hasting was born in Poplar, London on 21st March 1867. Her parents are not known. On 11th September 1893 she married Frederick William Evered at St. Andrews, Plaistow, Essex.

They had five children, Winifred Kate, Frederick Arthur, Evelyn Florence, Leonard John and Doris Sarah.

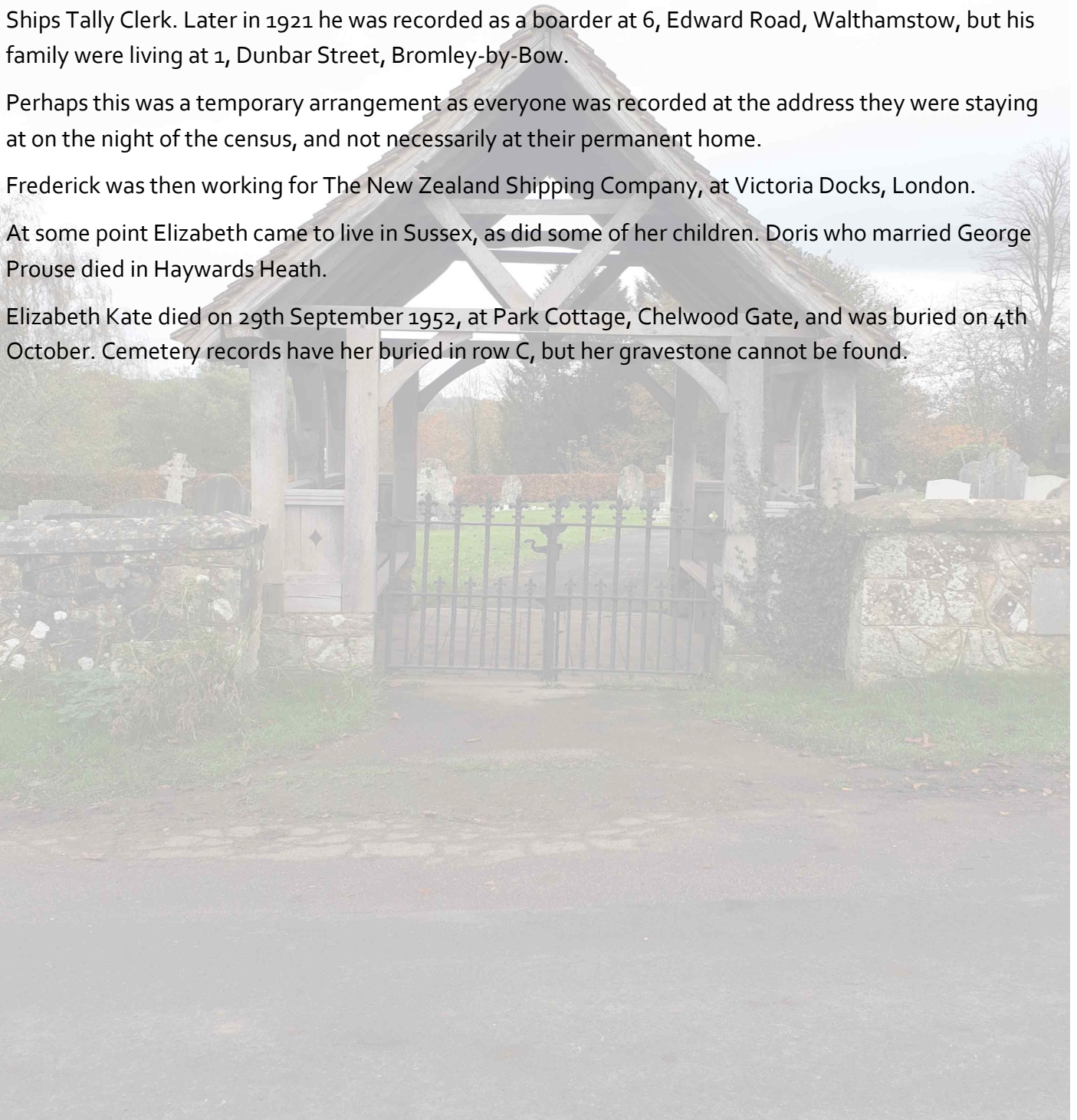
In 1911 the family were living at 226, Barking Road, East Ham, where Frederick senior was listed as a Ships Tally Clerk. Later in 1921 he was recorded as a boarder at 6, Edward Road, Walthamstow, but his family were living at 1, Dunbar Street, Bromley-by-Bow.

Perhaps this was a temporary arrangement as everyone was recorded at the address they were staying at on the night of the census, and not necessarily at their permanent home.

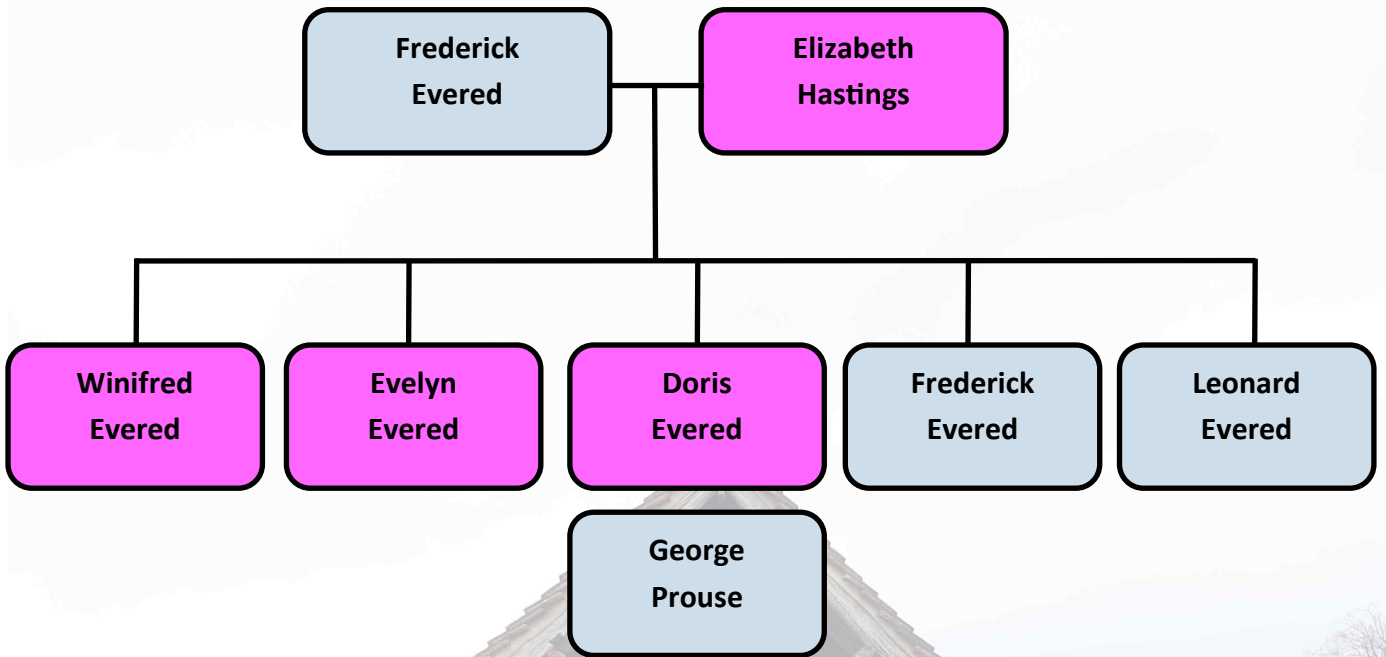
Frederick was then working for The New Zealand Shipping Company, at Victoria Docks, London.

At some point Elizabeth came to live in Sussex, as did some of her children. Doris who married George Prouse died in Haywards Heath.

Elizabeth Kate died on 29th September 1952, at Park Cottage, Chelwood Gate, and was buried on 4th October. Cemetery records have her buried in row C, but her gravestone cannot be found.
