Mary Grace Grinsted

Mary Grace Grinsted is buried in Danehill cemetery in row V. There is a small plaque stating she is buried there but there are no further details about her.

The Grinsted family did live next door to Birch Farm in a house called Shocks Bank (since been changed) So called because Mrs Nora Grinsted was the daughter of Mr Pinker who owned Shocks Bank which is the area of land which is now owned by Alan Bates (containing his pig Farm and fruit Farm etc).

Part of the Grinsted's house had been partitioned off and fitted out as the village butcher's shop. In 1930s -1950s a very thriving business with two delivery vans.

Mr and Mrs Grinsted (Joe and Nora) had two daughters, Pauline and Rosamond, both married and moved out of the district in the 1950s.

Mr & Mrs Grinsted moved to Nutley when they retired. Joe took up a part time job delivering meat for a Butcher in Uckfield.
