Elizabeth Money (nee Fryer)

June 1842 - 14 October 1931

Elizabeth Fryer was born in June 1842 in Elham, Stanford.

She married George Money in September 1868 in Canterbury and they had 5 children; Harriet Lucy was their first born in December 1869, in Canterbury, next came Emma Alice in March 1874 also born in Canterbury.

By the time Gertrude Fanny was born in March 1877 the family had moved to Edmonton. Another daughter, Minnie Elizabeth was born four years later in March 1877 also in Edmonton. Elizabeth and George's only son George William was born on 24th December 1885 in Edmonton.

Elizabeth's husband George Money, born in 1838 he died in 1900 in Edmonton.

Harriet Lucy married Charles Awcock in 1900 in Edmonton. Harriet died in 1946 at The Kent & Sussex Hospital, Tunbridge Wells. (see Awcock Family)

Emma Alice died on 25th November 1950 at The Hollies, Chelwood Gate. She is buried in Danehill.

Gertrude Fanny married William John Earnshaw in March 1904 in Woolwich.

Minnie Elizabeth lived with Emma Alice at The Hollies but died in 1965 in Plumstead having moved there after Emma Alice died. Her ashes were interred in her mother Elizabeth's grave in Danehill.

George William married Elizabeth Ann (Cis) Sheppard in September 1912 in Edmonton. He died in September 1946, and his wife Elizabeth died in 1973 in Enfield.


Elizabeth Money died on 14th October 1931 aged 89 years, at The Hollies, Chelwood Gate, where her daughter Emma Alice also lived. She was buried in Danehill on 19th October 1931.
