

## Ethel Cave Noble

23 June 1877—28 December 1965


Ethel Cave Noble was born on 23rd June 1877 in Chelsea, London. Her father James Noble was a tailor and in 1881 he employed 6 men. Ethel's mother's name was Jane Maria Cave and she married James on 8th September 1865 in Kent.

The 1881 census records the family living at 16, Kings Road, London. Ethel had 5 siblings; Minnie, James, Herbert, Percy and Ralph.

By 1891 Ethel, now 13 years old is living in Hampstead, as a domestic servant to Frederick Ward, a bootmaker.

In 1911 Ethel is recorded living with her father, and some of her siblings at 36, Oakhill Road, East Putney. Ethel did not marry and later in 1939 she lived with her brother Percy at Fincham Farm, Hartfield. Percy started his working life as a draper's assistant, becoming a tailor and then changing his profession to farmer. At some time between 1911 and 1939 moving to the farm in Hartfield.

At the time of her death on 28th December 1965, Ethel lived at Sedges, Danehill. She left £21,480 in her Will. She was 88 years old and was buried at Danehill cemetery on 31 December 1965.



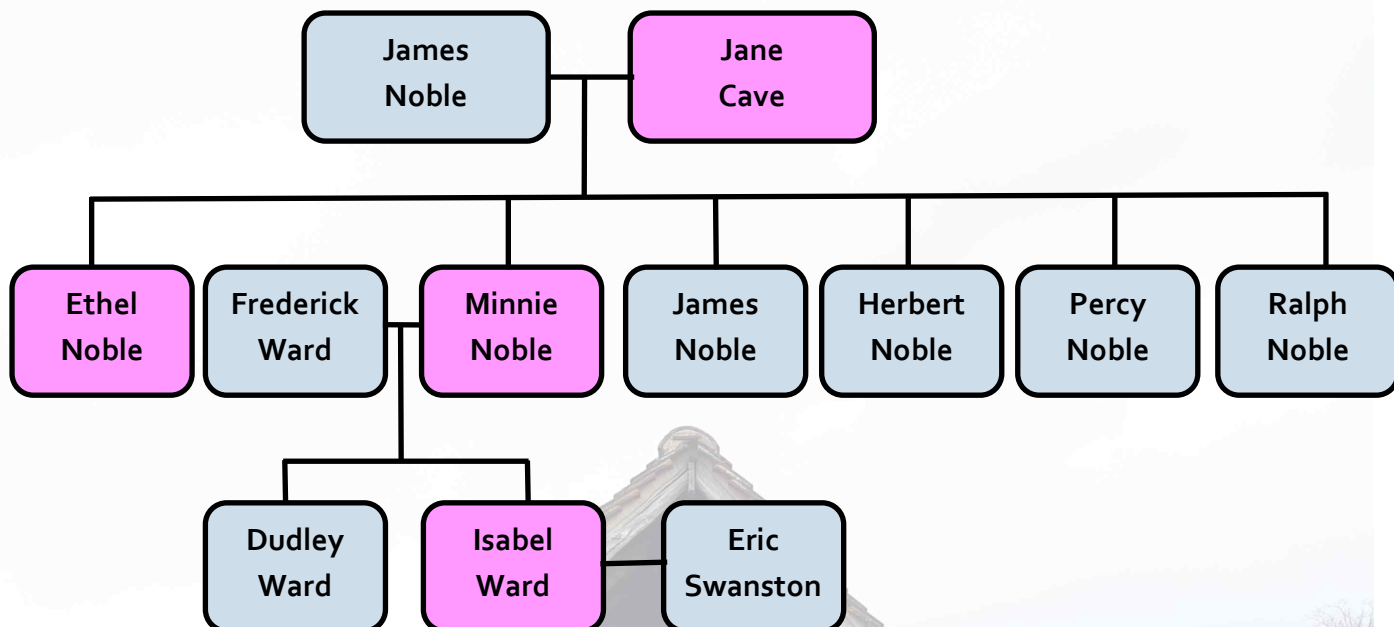
