

ALBERT STEPNEY

1865 - 21 January 1936

Albert was born in 1865 in West Grinstead. His father Henry Stepney (1818-1881) was a farmer with 63 acres and employed 2 men and a boy to help him run the farm. Albert's mother was Mary Styles (1834-????)

Albert, a journeyman corn miller, lived with his parents until his marriage to Ellen Newnham on 7th August 1893 at All Saints, Danehill.

In 1901 Albert and Ellen were living in Furners Green, and by 1911, still in Furners Green in a house with 5 rooms they had 4 children; Albert, Marjorie Kate, Margaret Kathleen, and Donald George.

Albert died 21st January 1936, aged 71, at Danewood Cottages, Danehill. He was buried at Danehill cemetery on 25th January 1936.

Ellen Stepney (nee Newnham)

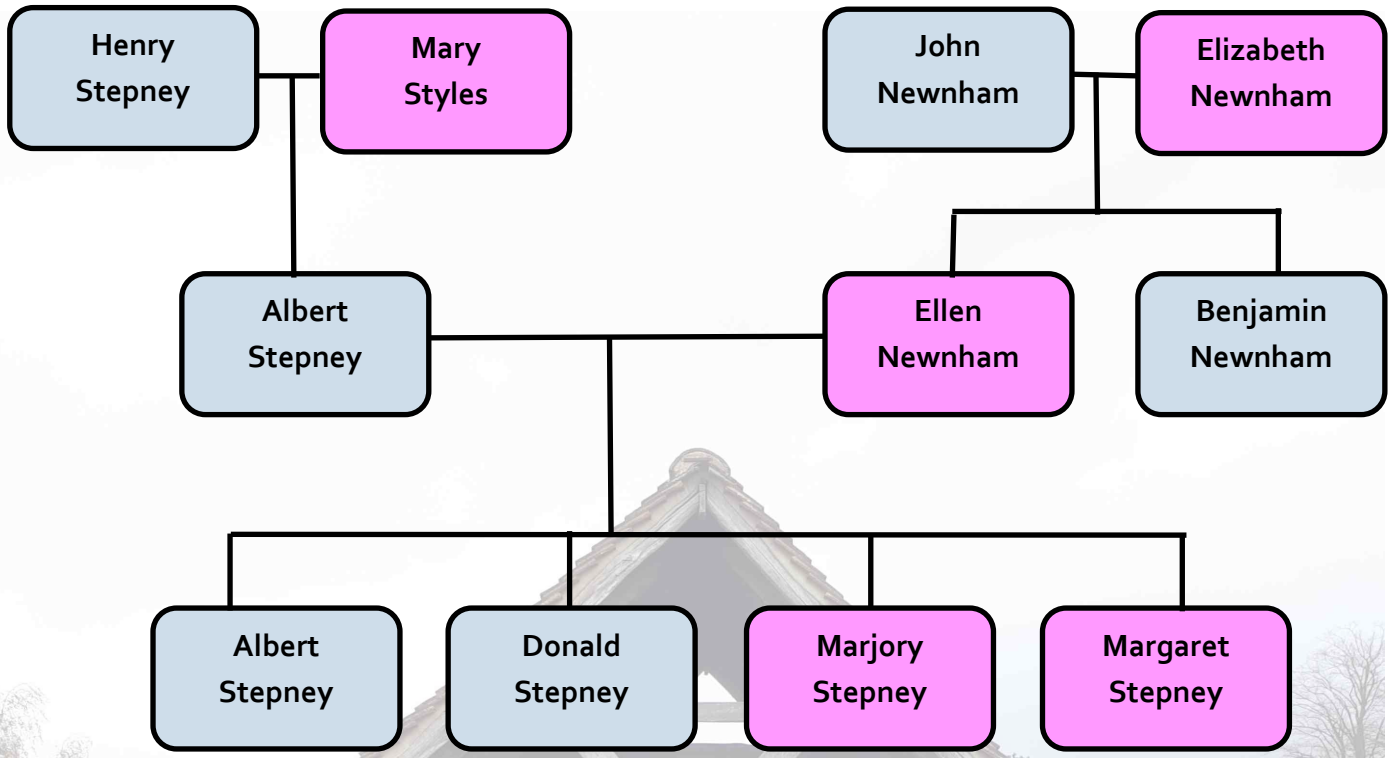
C1871 - 25 February 1949

Albert's wife Ellen Newnham, was the daughter of John and Elizabeth Newnham. John was a shoemaker and after he died, his wife Elizabeth a widow in 1871, carried on this trade. She employed 2 men and her son Benjamin became a boot maker following his father's trade.

After her mother Elizabeth died, Ellen lived with her brother Benjamin until her marriage to Albert Stepney in 1893. She died on 25th February 1949 at Danewood Cottages where she had lived with Albert, she was 78 years old. Ellen is buried in Danehill cemetery on 28th February 1949.
