

## Minnie Cave Ward (nee Noble)

**21 July 1867 - 14 August 1949**

Minnie Cave Noble was the sister of Ethel Cave Noble (see Noble family ) She was born on 21st July 1867 in Chelsea, London.

Her parents were James Noble and Jane Maria Cave.

Minnie married Frederick Henry Ward in 1890 at St. James Gunnersbury, London and they had 2 children, Dudley Cuthbert (1891-1945) and Isobel Ethel (1894-1992).

In 1901 the family were living at 10, Hollywood Villas, Wandsworth. Frederick was a Director of a Limited Liability Company of Boot Makers.

Now in 1911 the family have moved to 12, Melrose Road, South Shields, Wandsworth. The house is quite large with 9 rooms and they employ a general domestic servant, Emily Dorothy Deacon. Dudley, now a university student is still living at home along with Minnie's daughter Isobel.

In the 1939 register Frederick and Minnie are recorded living at Gillowheath, Bradham Lane, Exmouth, living on private means.

Minnie died on 14th August 1949 at Fineham Farm, Hartfield. She was buried at Danehill cemetery on 16th August 1949. She left £ 3171 3s 1d in her Will to her daughter Isobel Ethel Swanston, who was a widow. Frederick had died in 1943.

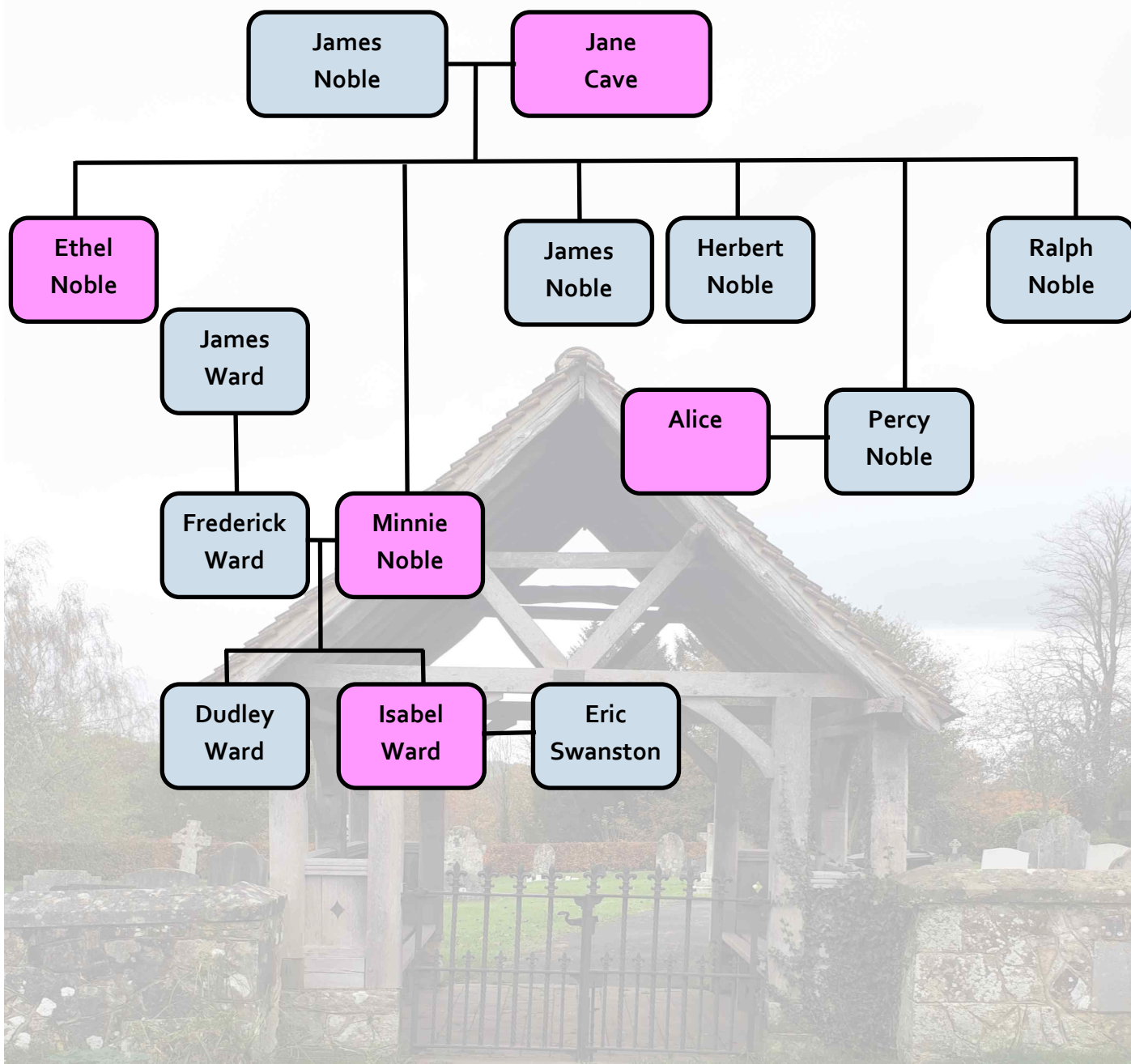
