Thomas Warnett

29 July 1810 - 28 February 1896

Thomas was born on 29th July 1810 in Fletching. His father was George Warnett (1764-1849) and his mother was Elizabeth Beard (1761-1842).

Thomas was the youngest of 10 children, his siblings were; Ann, William, Elizabeth, Mary, Sarah, Lucy, Sophia, George, and John.

Thomas married Mary Martin on 8th June 1841 in Horsted Keynes. They had 4 children; Edwin, Walter G, Alfred Thomas and Mary Ann.

In 1871 the family were living art Gedleigh Farm, Danehil where Thomas was a farmer of 31 acres.

They were still at the farm in 1881, but by now Thomas is listed on the census as a carpenter. They are employing a general servant, Julia Langridge.

After his wife Mary died in 1882 Thomas moved to The Police Station Cottage, in Horsted Keynes, as a lodger with Many Coppard.

Thomas died on 28th February 1896, aged 85. He was buried at Danehill cemetery on 4th March 1896

Mary Warnett (nee Martin)

1817 - 4 March 1882

Mary Martin was born c. 1817 in Fletching.

She married Thomas Warnett and had 4 children.

Mary died on the 4th March 1882, at Horsted Brook, aged 65. She was buried at Danehill cemetery on 10th March 1882

George Warnett

1804 - 1 December 1858

George was born on 10th June 1804 in Fletching, he was the son of George and Elizabeth Warnett and brother to Thomas.

He married Mary Brown on 11th October 1834 in Horsted Keynes and they had 6 children; William (1835-???), George (1838-1892), Elizabeth (1841-1935), Charlotte (1844-????), Peter (1848-1928) and Phillip (1848-1892).

In 1851 George and Mary were living near Pepper Alley, Danehill, his occupation was an agricultural labourer.

George died on 1st December 1858 aged 54 years.

Elizabeth Warnett

1 February 1793 - 10 August 18??

Elizabeth Warnett was born on 1st February 1793 she was the sister of Thomas and George Warnett. She died on 10th August 18??, aged 76.
