

Henry White

1803 - 13 July 1872

Henry White was born in Hackney, East London, about 1803. His parents were John White and Ann (?)

Henry married Elizabeth Partridge on 17th July 1830 in Hackney and they moved to Sussex. The census of 1841 lists them as living in Horsted Keynes, but by 1861 they were in Danehill and Henry is a grocer and draper. In 1871 they have their own shop in Danehill and are employing Ann Burtenshaw as a domestic servant.

As well as having the grocers shop Henry is a farmer of 20 acres, and employs one man and one boy to help him run the farm.

Henry and Elizabeth did not have children and Henry died on 13th July 1872. He was buried at Danehill cemetery on 16th July 1872. In his Will he left under £600.

Elizabeth died on 30th August 1883 in Danehill. Her family were originally from Framfield.

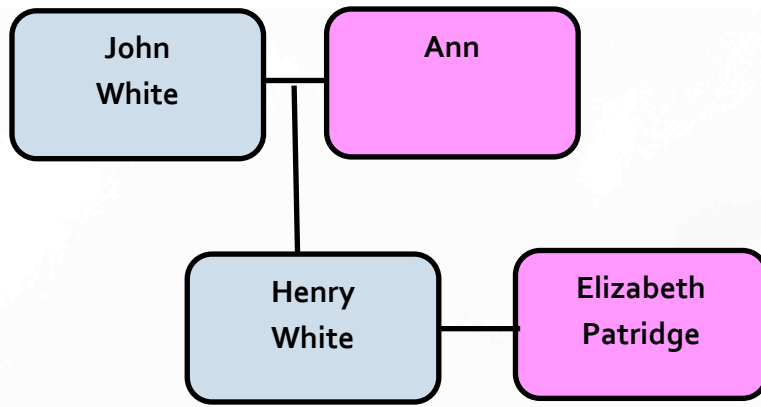
