

Cara Dashwood Cavendish Wolfgang

2 August 1880 - 22 July 1952

Cara Dashwood Wolfgang was born on 2nd August 1880 in London. Her father was Mark John Wolfgang (1857-????) and her mother was Emily Fanner (1847-1901). Cara's grandfather, Mark Schmel Wolfgang was Hungarian.

Her brother Reginald Wolfgang was born in 1883 and died in 1929 on The Isle of Wight.

The first mention of Cara is in the 1891 census when she and her mother were visiting her Aunt Mathilda at 14, Springfield Road, Preston, Brighton.

In 1901 Cara is living with her aunt at 121, Waldegrave Road, Preston, Brighton. By 1911 Cara is at 21, Lancaster Park, Richmond, Surrey, where she is a lady's companion to Madeline Donovan.

Cara became a physiotherapist and is listed in The Register of Physiotherapy and Masseur 1895-1980. Cara is listed in the telephone directory of 1950 living at Lancaster Park, so that suggests she was the head of the household.

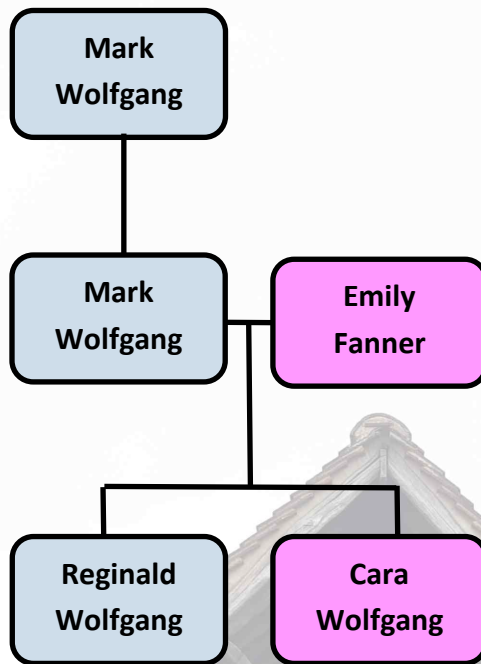
She died there on 22nd July 1952 aged 71 years.
